## A) GENERAL

- 1) These supplemental rules are used in addition to the AMA Sports Rule Book. This Rule Book may be amended or adjusted at any time as situations arise.
- 2) The event officials may act on any issue concerning safety at any time.
- 3) Participants who do not feel comfortable with the event proceedings as explained herein are encouraged to forego competing in this event.

### B) 2024 AMA ICE OVAL AMATEUR GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS

1) The AMA will award ICE OVAL Grand Championships to the winners of every class <u>except</u> the 250cc Rubber Open class.

### C) ICE RACE CLASSES

### D) ELIGIBILITY

1) Any racer who held/holds a 2023 or 2024 American Flat Track professional racing license is ineligible to compete for a 2024 AMA ICE OVAL National Championship.

### E) EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

- 1) **CAMERAS**. Per AMA rules, cameras and other accessories cannot be mounted onto the helmet. This includes Go-Pro cameras.
- 2) **FENDERS**: Each machine must have protective front and rear fenders which prevent an arm or leg from getting into the screws.



- a) The front fender must extend from horizontal line through the front axle center to a line vertical to the fork bottom triple clamp.
- b) The rear fender must extend rearward through a horizontal line passing through the center of the rear axle. The rear fender must also extend forward past a vertical line passing through the center of the rear axle.
- c) No guards that allow access to the screws are permitted.
- d) All fenders must be no more than 2 inches away from the screws, and constructed so that an arm or leg cannot get between the fender, number plate or rear tire.



3) FULL-SIZED BIKES. All machines competing in the 2024 AMA ICE OVAL GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS event must be full sized two-wheeled machines. Per the AMA rulebook, 53" minimum wheelbase and 17" minimum wheels. No pit bikes, minibikes, or boonie bikes are allowed to compete.

- 4) **ELECTRIC MACHINES**. Electric machines are eligible to compete in any class that does not have an upper displacement limit, except Hooligan.
- 5) **KICK STANDS**. All kick stands and safety bars must be removed.
- 6) MUFFLERS. All machines must have a muffler. The 2024 AMA ICE OVAL GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS event takes place on a public lake, and we must respect our neighbors if we expect to be allowed to continue hosting this event.
- 7) SCREWS: All machines must have AMA-legal screws.
  - a) Sheet metal screws with a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" hexagonal washer head with no more than one straight screwdriver slot.
  - b) Overall head height from under washer 3/16" (0.1875"  $\pm$  0.006").
  - c) Maximum head washer diameter: 0.350".
  - d) Screwdriver slot not to exceed 0.085".
  - e) Screw height not to exceed 3/16" (0.1875" ± 0.006") above tire. No added washers. Base of screw must contact rubber of tire.
  - f) No screw modification from production allowed, such as sharpening, etc.

## 8) **TETHER SWITCHES**

- a) All machines must be equipped with tether-type kill switches not buttons or other types of switches.
- b) The tether cord must be **fastened** directly around the racer's wrist, not to his/her clothing.

### 9) **TIRES**

- a) Tire cutting or re-grooving is not permitted in studded classes.
  - (1) Cutting involves using a sharp object (razor, knife, etc.).

## F) EQUIPMENT INSPECTIONS

- 1) Officials may inspect any machine at any time.
- 2) Unapproved machines are not permitted to participate in the event.
- 3) Machines that fail on-the-spot inspections particularly with respect to fenders, tether switches, and/or screws will not be allowed onto, or back onto, the course.
- 4) Pre-Race Inspection
  - a) All machines will be inspected by event officials prior to practice.
- 5) Post-Race Inspection
  - a) The top 3 machines in each final will be inspected at the conclusion of the event. Location TBD.
  - b) Machines which do not complete a post-race inspection for any reason will be disqualified.

## G) CONDUCT & PENALTIES

1) All participants are expected to clean up their area(s) during, and before departing, the event. Any trash left behind jeopardizes the ability of the venue to invite us back.

- Pit riding of any kind will not be tolerated. Any racer or team found to operate their machine beyond a WALKING SPEED anywhere on the grounds except on the racetrack during the racing will be disqualified.
- 3) Any racers and/or family and/or pit crew who direct foul or abusive language to any official of the 2024 AMA ICE OVAL GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS are subject to disqualification from the entire event, and possibly future 2024 AMA ICE OVAL GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS events. Each racer is responsible for the actions of his/her family and pit crew, and any detrimental action by those individuals puts the racer at risk for disqualification.

### **H) PROTESTS**

- 1) Protests must be submitted in writing using a completed AMA protest form.
- 2) The author of the protest must be a competitor in the same class as the individual being protested.
- 3) The author of the protest must be directly affected by the outcome of the protest.
- 4) Each protest must refer to a single subject only and must be very specific.
- 5) A protest must be filed with the Meet Referee within 30 minutes after the final results have been posted.
- 6) A protest fee of \$500 cash must accompany the protest.
- 7) If a tear-down is required for the protest, additional fees including, but not limited to the follow, will apply:
  - a) \$150 for measuring the displacement of a two-stroke engine
  - b) \$300 for measuring the displacement of a four-stroke engine
  - c) \$100 is splitting the cases is required.

### I) MINORS

- Participants under the legal age of majority (18) will not be allowed to compete without the written consent of both his/her parents or legal guardians. If both parents are unable to attend the event, a notarized, color copy of the form (available at <u>www.dairylandclassic.com/iceoval/</u>) must be completed and turned in at the event registration. The parents, legal guardian, or authorized adult must remain present while the minor racer he/she is responsible for is at the meet.
- All classes in the in the 2024 AMA ICE OVAL GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS are designated as AMATEUR classes. Minimum rider age is 12 years of age on the day of the event. Some classes may have additional age restrictions.
- 3) Participants must be at least 14 years old to compete on a machine larger than 250cc.
- 4) Participants must be at least 17 years old to compete on a twin-cylinder machine larger than 250cc.
- 5) Any racer who is unable to provide proof of age may be denied entry or disqualified from the event.
